

## **Transportation Cabinet Official Order No. 112169 – Live Video Chat Format Sheriff’s**

### **Inspections**

The attached order from the Transportation Cabinet allows for a live video chat format for performing certified sheriff’s inspections.

Until the Expiration of the Commonwealth-wide state of emergency, certified sheriff’s inspectors may perform necessary vehicle inspections using a secure live video chat function that allows them to fully satisfy the requirements of KRS 186A.115 and 601 KAR 9:090 without having to violate social distancing orders by performing inspections physically, or in-person.

Check with your Sheriff’s office to determine if this option is available in your county.
